

Request for Applications: Rombauer Fellowship for Junior Faculty

The UCSF Pancreas Center invites applications for faculty support from the Joan Rombauer UCSF Endowed Fellowship. This Endowment was established to support career development for faculty who wish to do research on pancreatic ductal adenocarcinoma or pancreatic neuroendocrine tumors.

The applicant may be in any academic track and must be an assistant professor appointed for less than 5 years. Other funding (such as, but not limited to, extramural career developmental awards, K series, R21, R01) is allowed.

AWARD: \$50,000/yr for up to 3 years. Funding may be used for salary and/or relevant projects.

APPLICATION GUIDELINES: All applications (in a single pdf file) must be submitted via email to kurt.giles@ucsf.edu and should include:

- 1) Overview of research: **no more than 2 pages** (exclusive of references)
- 2) Budget with justification for all proposed expenses
- 3) NIH biosketch and list of other support
- 4) Letter of Support from the Chair of the academic unit detailing the departmental commitment to the faculty member.

DEADLINE FOR SUBMISSION: 5:00pm PST, Friday October 1st, 2021.

The selected candidate will be notified in November and funding is expected to start January 1st, 2022.
