

Information Available to Researchers from the UCSF Cancer Registry Database

Procedure: Contact the Cancer Registry and ask for a Data Request Form. All information released (except unidentifiable aggregate data) must be accompanied by a CHR approval letter and a copy of the research proposal. The proposal must include a statement(s) indicating that the Cancer Registry information database will be used in the research.

The following highlights some of the information available:
